2009 Co-Rec Cedar Lane Softball Classic

Ages 18 - up

The tournament will provide three ASA approved balls to each team before the tournament begins. Additional balls may be purchased at the site, \$5 each.

The registration deadline is Friday, May 29, 2009. Entry and fee must be received by the deadline.

Type of competition: Three games guaranteed

Tournament Rules

1. Unless modified here, all games will be played in accordance with the current Amateur Softball Association (A.S.A.) Slow Pitch Softball rules.
2. Rosters are limited to 20 players.
3. Players shall wear the same color shirt.
4. Games will start at their scheduled starting times. **NO GRACE PERIOD!**
5. When each batter enters the batter's box, he/she shall have the count of one ball and one strike. After the batter has reached two strikes, he/she will be declared out when he/she hits a second foul ball.
6. A game may start and/or be played with a minimum of nine players. An automatic out will be taken for the vacant spot in the line-up. If a tenth player arrives after the start of a game, he/she shall bat in the tenth position. A team shall consist of five men and five women. If a team is playing with nine players, there must be at least four of each sex in the line-up at all times. In the case of nine players, the line-up must begin with the sex which has five players. (Exception: Six men and six women must be used if using the A.S.A. "E.P." Dropping below the required 12 players will result in forfeiture.)
7. Coaches may place players in any defensive position. There are no restrictions on male/female defensive placement of players.
8. Home team will be determined by a coin toss.
9. 10-run rule, 65 minute time limit.
10. Metal spikes are prohibited.
11. Any player ejected from a game will automatically be suspended from participation in the remainder of the tournament.
12. All protests must be settled on the field. Player eligibility protests must be filed prior to the completion of the game in which the ineligible player participated.
13. All games must be official. In the event of rain or if any other cause interrupts a game which is not official, the game must be resumed at the exact point it stopped.
14. Three home runs will be allowed per team, per game with any additional home runs ruled an out.
15. Each team shall furnish one new ball at the start of each game. If additional balls are needed, the team at bat shall furnish as many ASA approved balls as needed to complete their turn at bat.
16. All bats banned for use by ASA are banned for use in all Howard County sponsored tournaments.
